# WHAT IS THE FOUNDATIONS ASSESSMENT

The Foundations Assessment is a guided discovery process that evaluates your organization's digital environment across fifteen core domains—from people and devices to data, vendors, and everyday workflows.

You do not need cybersecurity expertise. You do not need perfect documentation. **You do not need to have everything “figured out.”**

The assessment gives you:

- ❖ A clear snapshot of your current digital foundations
- ❖ A prioritized view of strengths, gaps, and emerging risks
- ❖ A practical action plan sized for small teams
- ❖ A shared language for conversations with staff, leadership, and board members

And equally important, here's what the assessment is **not**:

- ❖ It is **not** a compliance audit
- ❖ It is **not** a pass/fail score
- ❖ It is **not** an assessment of staff performance
- ❖ It is **not** a measure of how “behind” you are

It is a reality-mapping tool. A clear, calm picture of where you stand today – so you can make thoughtful decisions about tomorrow.

# READINESS LENS #1: OPERATIONAL CAPACITY

The Foundations Assessment typically takes 60–90 minutes and can be completed by one or two staff members who understand how daily operations work. You do not need technical expertise – just a working understanding of how your organization uses email, files, donations, equipment, and communications tools.

You may be ready if:

- ❖ You have at least one person who can set aside dedicated time to complete the assessment
- ❖ You can gather basic information about how your systems and processes work
- ❖ You are willing to answer honestly, even if some answers are “Not sure”

The Assessment works best when the person completing it has a broad view of operations rather than deep technical knowledge. Executive directors, operations managers, and office administrators often make excellent respondents.

## READINESS LENS #2: CULTURAL APPETITE

The Assessment provides clarity – and clarity is most powerful when leadership teams are open to seeing the full picture.

You may be ready if:

- ❖ Leadership wants a shared understanding of risk and responsibility
- ❖ There is curiosity about strengthening digital practices
- ❖ Your team is willing to learn, even if some findings feel new or unexpected

The best results happen when organizations approach the Assessment with a posture of learning, not defensiveness.

## READINESS LENS #3: EMOTIONAL BANDWIDTH

Every Foundations report contains a mix of “you’re doing this well” and “here’s where improvement would help.” This is normal, expected, and universal across mission-driven organizations.

You may be ready if:

- ❖ Your team has space to receive clear information without feeling overwhelmed
- ❖ You can view recommendations as guidance – not criticism
- ❖ You want confidence, not perfection
